

Bought this book for my son, who was having some self esteem issues at school. He is the only boy of color in his classroom and I felt that he needed to see images of himself or similar, in a book that talked about being yourself and loving who you are. Very cute book. He likes to be read to, but he reads it himself all the time too. I think it did the trick, especially since the character in the book talks about superheros and my kids are superhero crazy!!

We were looking for books about self acceptance and loved that this had African American people in it, but this book is really about being okay with being a twin.

Very cute story. I read this in my class of 1st and 2nd graders and they really liked it. After reading it

together, we did an activity where we made a mini book about how marvelous we were. Each student made a book and wrote about their favorite things and what they looked like, what makes them special/marvelous, etc.

This story doesn't flow well for younger readers. I love the message, but the book is much suited for a child who is in 4th or 5th grade. Unfortunately the students in those grades are reading chapter books by then. Great message, if you have a very advanced 2nd or 3rd grader.

When I bought this book, I did not realize that there would be a section addressing twins. This book helps children appreciate their individual selves even with siblings. My children are not twins but they are close in age (2 and 3) and are often mistaken for twins. This book teaches self-esteem and responsibility. Great book.

I love this book. The character was great because he looked like my son. There needs to be more books with children of color.

I purchased this for my friend's son because she was struggling to find books with black characters. I bought this book and five others along with James Baldwin's, *Fire Next Time* and sent them all in a package with a letter for her son to open when he turns 13. Each year, I'll be purchasing a plethora of books with characters that look like him that also teach him his heritage and this book was included in the first package I sent him, which was a huge hit! I'm so excited to find more books like this to send to my friend's precious son! So grateful to have found this!
