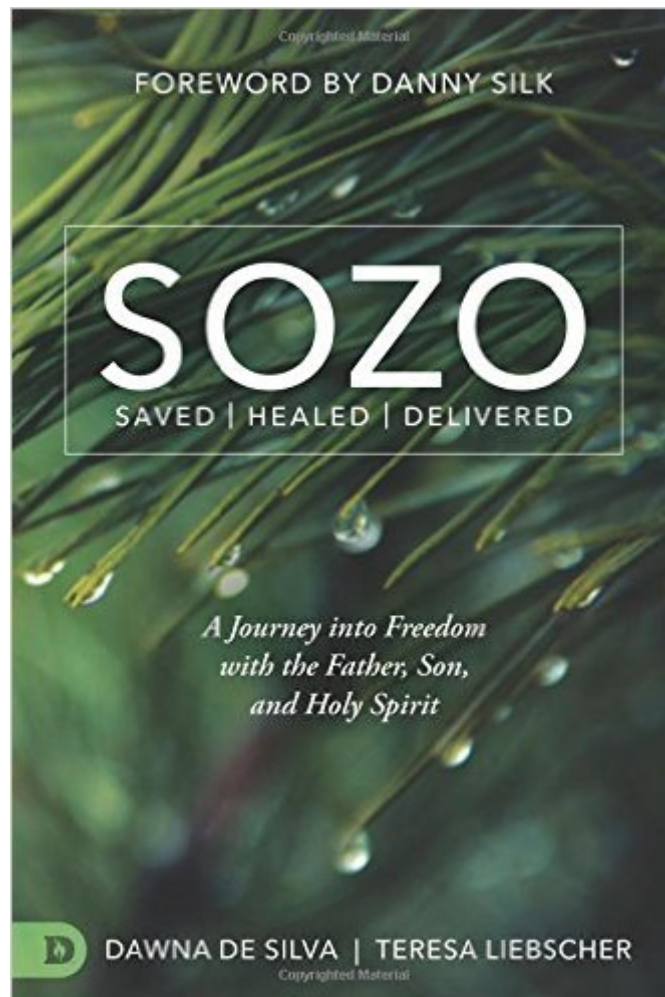

It explains what they are, why and how these tools are helpful, and gives short case histories of these tools in action, questions to ask and prayers to pray.
