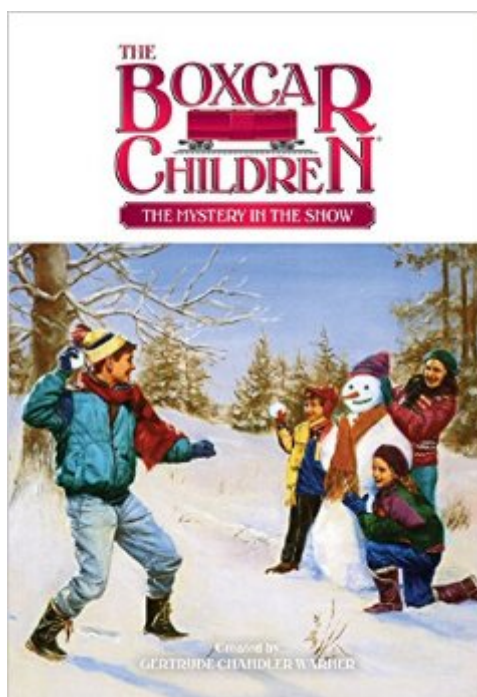


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# The Mystery In The Snow (The Boxcar Children, No. 32)
