I purchased this book for my first grade classroom. We do a unit of study on the elements of a non-fiction text. The Time for Kids books are wonderful for this unit. They have terrific pictures (which the kids love), and many elements of a non-fiction text, such as labeling, comparisions, captions, glossary, types of print, etc. I would highly recommend this book - really all of the time for kids books - to those looking for appropriate non-fiction books for a first grade classroom. The level 1 and 2 books are most appropriate.

I ordered this book for my students and they really love it. It is especially good for students who do not like to read because all the pages are mainly pictures about spiders and interesting facts about them. The vocabulary is very good for a second or third grader.

I recently read this book to a group of students and they were immediately captivated by the amazing photos and interesting and unusual facts about spiders. This book will grab and hold a young reader's attention and adults will love it too! I had to order this book as a replacement for the one I lost from school. It arrived in two days as promised.

This informative book is a great resource for early learners. We used it for a unit on Spiders and it even has an AR Quiz!

My daughter has read this book several times and loves to quiz me on spiders, I now know more about those creepy crawlies than I want to know. Did you know a spider's silk can stretch 50 feet without breaking? or that spiders wait for their prey/food to come to them? Time books for kids are colourful and easy to read and learn from. We use time for kids for most of my daughter's book reports.

What can we say! It is a lot of fun to look at all the creepy pictures of these interesting spiders. The cover is just the beginning! My 6 year old loved it, and is begging to have me read it again... thank heaven he is learning to read!

I gave it to my 3-year-old son for his birthday, and he really likes it. The photos are nice, and there are a lot of different-looking spiders, so every page isn't the same. I highly recommend.
